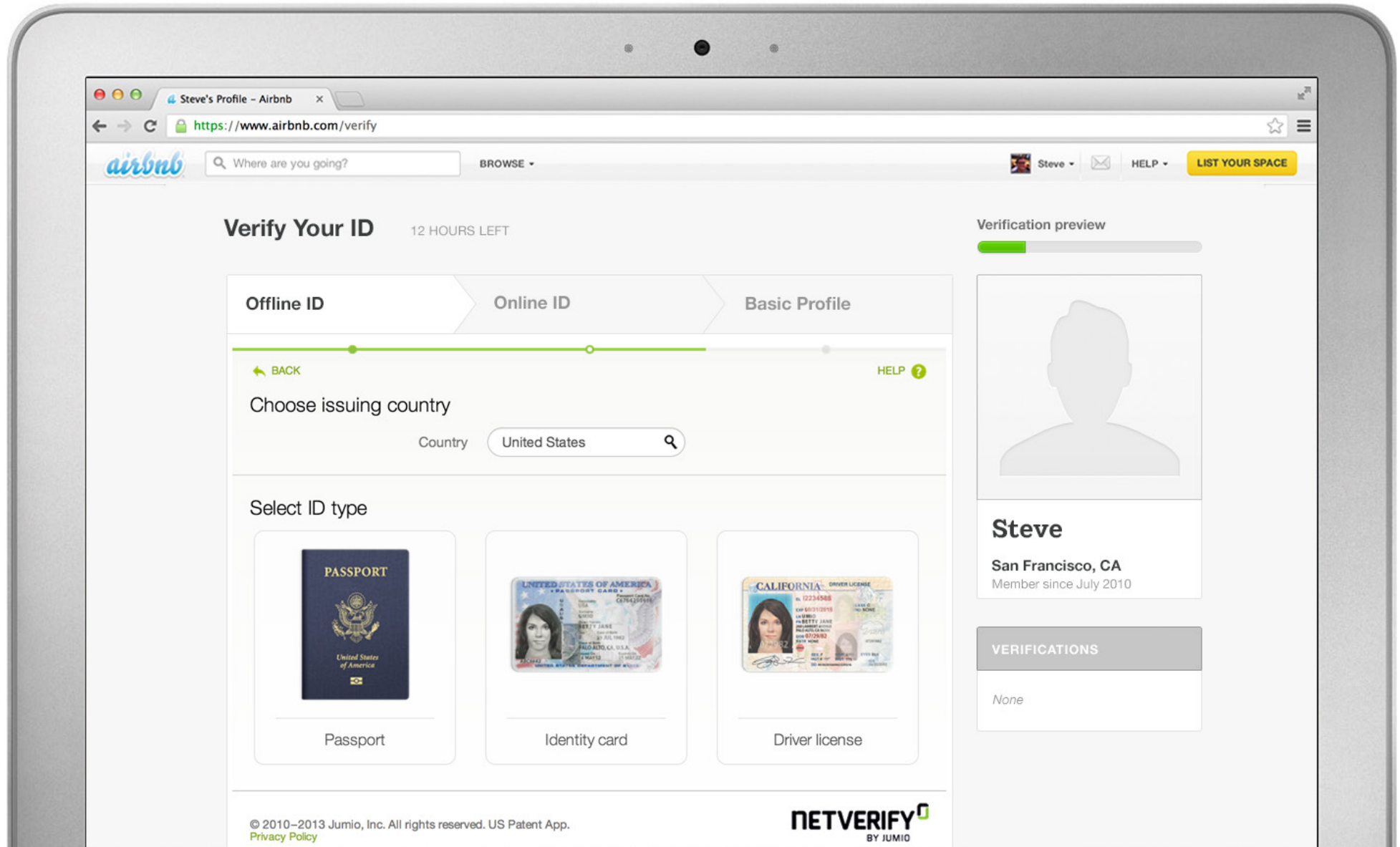

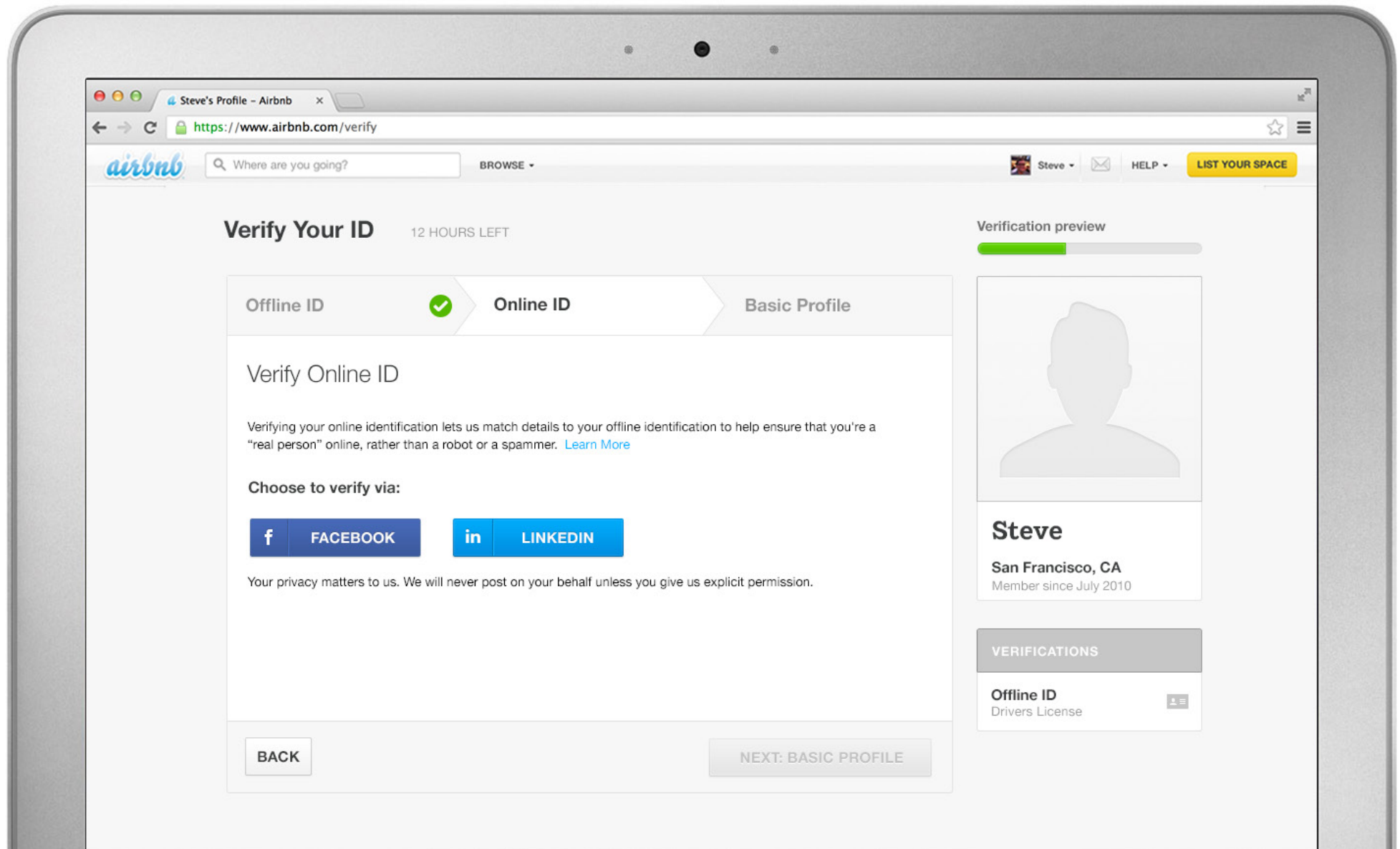
Users are prompted to scan an official ID or to provide historical personal information.



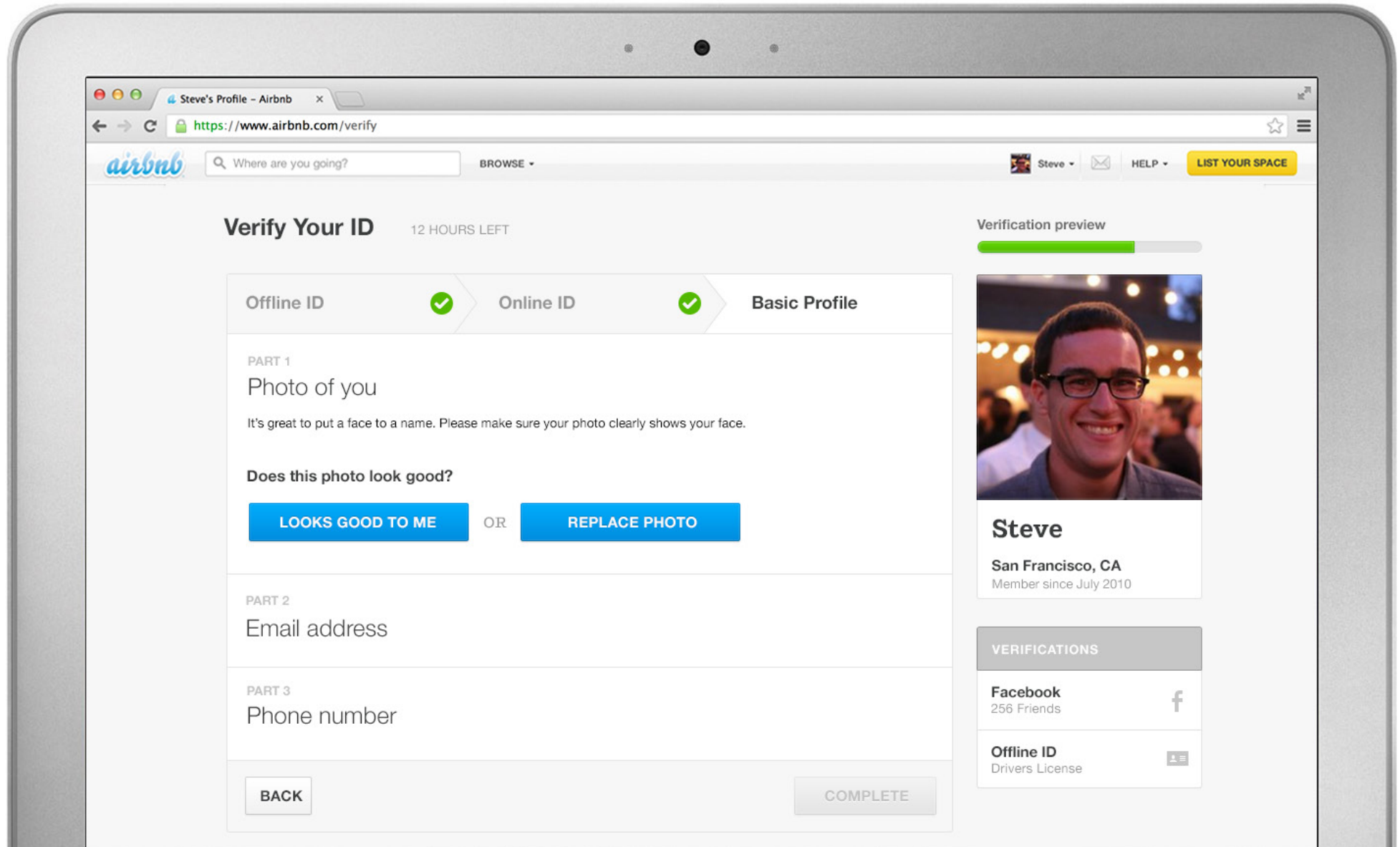
This user chooses to scan their official ID.
